- Design and format educational materials (e.g., presentations, written guides, infographics) for delivery via platforms like Google Classroom, social media, or other organizational channels.
- Assist in creating materials for the continuing education of IGG volunteers on topics like genealogical methodology, ethical standards, and data security.

Program Support & Implementation:

- Aid in the preparation and logistics for internal training sessions delivered by the Volunteer Education Team.

- Support the creation of materials for external education programs aimed at agency partners (law enforcement), the genetic genealogy community, and the general public.
- Assist with the development and delivery of content for volunteer practicum programs.

Quality Assurance:

- Review and proofread educational resources to ensure accuracy, clarity, and consistency with Compass IGG & Advocacy's professional standards.
